#### **Self Determination**


We defend the right of all individuals to create lives of their own choosing.

- Diversity social complexity


The more complex the goal, the more dense and robust the community needs to be. The more complex the goal the higher the trust within the community needs to be.

#### Core


- Personalize

- Engage with food




## **Strategies for Community Building**

# **Asset Mapping (Reciprocal Relationships)**




## Strategies to Leverage Expertise

- Affirm lived experience
- Honor the whole person
- Identify interests, expertise, skills
- Customize (person-centered, site-specific)
- Train the trainer (popular education)
