





# Humboldt County, CA - Population: 136,646










  - Lock boxes
- Modeling/teaching life skills



### Integrated Practices

- Fluid team structuring allows for multiple touch points for newly housed clients
- Client driven goals in housing. Using interdisciplinary approach to ensure positive outcomes.
- Importance of communication ROIs for landlord/property managers, medical providers, housing applications, SSI, General Relief, etc.

### Barriers – to services and housing

- The struggles of the newly housed
- Teaching good neighbor skills
- Connecting with resources to enhance self-sufficiency and addressing harm reduction
  - General Relief, SSI, Section 8, employment opportunities
- Housing Coordinator works with the landlords/property managers to address issues

 Applying for other programs such as IHSS to assist clients in maintaining housing


